Bond Referendum to Be Placed on Nov. Ballot



On August 2, the Fuquay-Varina Town Board authorized two Bond Referenda questions for the November 2, 2021 ballot.

Specifically, the Town Board authorized referenda for \$18.5-million in Parks and Recreation investments, and an additional \$20-million for Transportation improvements.

Should these two questions be approved by voters in November, the Town of Fuquay-Varina will utilize the funding resources for various Parks and Recreation improvements that may include a Community Center, Active Adult Center, general park upgrades and various transportation improvements throughout the Fuquay-Varina community.

Face Coverings Required in Town Facilities

In response to new guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), beginning August 5 and until further notice, face coverings are required indoors for Town employees and visitors (ages 5 and up) to Town of Fuquay-Varina facilities regardless of vaccination status.

Currently, there are no plans to cancel indoor or outdoor Town of Fuquay-Varina events. For indoor events, Town staff and patrons will be required to wear masks. For outdoor events, there are no current plans to require masks.

Additionally, there are no immediate plans to reinstate virtual-only Town Board meetings. The plan is to continue monitoring CDC guidance and adjust as needed. Therefore, the public remains invited to attend meetings in person, however the Town will continue to limit capacity to 50% of seating availability on a first-come basis. A mask will be required unless addressing the Town Board at the podium. As an alternative to attending in person, public meetings can be viewed on Facebook and YouTube. Town Hires New Economic Development Director



The Town of Fuquay-Varina is pleased to announce the hiring of Tiffany McNeill as the Town's new Economic Development Director. McNeill assumes her new role on August 30.

She is also a Certified Economic Developer (CEcD) through the International Economic Development Council.
