



Transportation Projects are Moving Ahead

The Town continues to focus significant efforts on road improvements in Fuquay-Varina. Below is an update on several transportation projects:

NW Judd Parkway Construction to Begin

In Dec. 2018, the Town Board approved a contract with S. T. Wooten Corp. in the amount of \$12,468,619 for completion of the final section of the NW Judd Parkway Project. Town staff and consultant Kimley-Horn have worked to navigate the complex design and ROW acquisition process, as well as the environmental permitting necessary to bring the project to fruition.

The total project budget, including design, ROW and construction costs is \$24,800,000. The project is paid for through a combination of financing including \$8.65 million in LAPP grant funding with the remainder paid from bonds approved by tax payers in the 2015 Transportation Bond. Construction is anticipated to begin in early Feb. 2019 with the road open for use in 2020.

NE Judd Intersection 90% Complete

Construction on the NE Judd Intersection Project, which began one year ago, is 90% complete with all lanes open. New traffic signals will be installed this winter. Thermoplastic markings cannot be installed until spring due to seasonal limitations. The total project budget is over \$7 million and is funded through a combination of grants and bonds approved by tax payers in 2015. The project added lanes on NE Judd Parkway from Old Honeycutt Road past the Walmart shopping center.

Old Honeycutt Rd./Purfoy Rd. Intersection

In Oct. 2018, the Town Board award a contract to Kimley-Horn for design and permitting of this project with construction anticipated to begin by early fall of 2019 and completion expected during the first half of 2020. The project will add lanes and increase traffic flow at the intersection. The total project is expected to cost \$1.2 million with the town paying 25% of the cost and LAPP grant funding paying the remaining 75% of the cost. The Town's portion will be paid for through bonds approved in 2015.

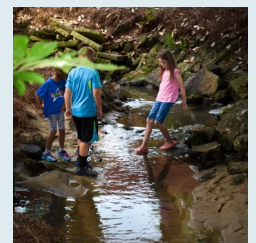

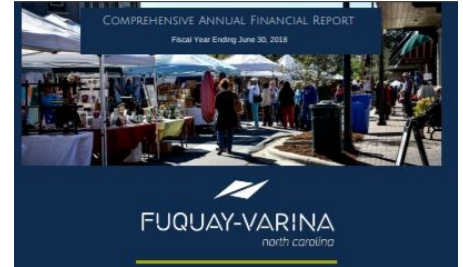

The Town of Fuquay-Varina has released its Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 for public review. A CAFR provides a higher level of reporting than an audit report with more financial detail covering not only the current year, but the previous 10 years, and provides valuable insights on how the Town manages finances.



The Town of Fuquay-Varina has received the Certificate for Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting from the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) for the past three years and will apply for this award of distinction this year as well.
