In accordance with discussions at the February 18, 2003, meeting of the Town Board, the following insurance requirement schedule should be officially adopted.

I would also recommend that these amounts be reviewed in conjunction with the budget process each year.

- Developer Performance \$2 million
- Special Events, Parades, etc. (other than assemblies only) \$1 million
- Assemblies Only \$500,000
- Taxi Franchise \$500,000

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**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR  
SPECIAL EVENTS FOR THE TOWN OF FUQUAY-VARINA**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF  
FUQUAY-VARINA:**

Part 6; Chapter 2; Article C of the Town Code of Ordinances is amended by adding a new section as follows:

**Section 6-2030 – Insurance Requirements**

The organizer or operator of any special event, parade, activity or assembly event, shall provide to the Town written evidence of insurance satisfactory to requirements set forth by the Board of Commissioners that such event, parade, activity or assembly event is insured against property damage, bodily injury and wrongful death. The Board of Commissioners may promulgate, from time to time, written policies and agreements, and requirements regarding the amounts of coverage and forms of coverage for such activities, parades, events or assembly event.
