

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: What are the hours of the park?

A: Sunrise to sunset, 7 days a week

Q: Where do we park?

A: The parking lot is located at 4621 Shady Greens Drive, Fuquay-Varina.

Q: What are the features of the park?

A: There are 5 miles of paved trails of varying elevation, open green space, multiple ponds, and a wide variety of wildlife including turtles, fish, and herons.

Q: Where can I find a list of the rules and regulations?

A: Listed above and posted on each of three information kiosks within the park. See [trail map](#) for kiosk locations.

Q: How large is the park?

A: 143 acres/23 acres future school site.

Q: I want to choose the right trail for me - What are the characteristics of each trail?

A: The 2.1-mile Yellow trail is the most moderate with few changes in elevation and a view of the largest pond on the property; the .6-mile Blue trail is a shorter walk with a slightly more challenging elevation change; the 2.2-mile Red trail contains the most challenging elevation changes, and includes smaller ponds and a view from the highest point at the park.

Q: Are restrooms available and where are they located?

A: There is a restroom along the yellow trail and one along the red trail. See [trail map](#).

Q: Where will the future elementary school with Wake County Public Schools be located?

A: A future elementary school will be located south of current parking lot, on the former driving range. For more information, visit the Wake County Public School Facilities Design and Construction webpage at <https://www.wcpss.net/Page/3925?pid=213>

Q: What is the timeline for future plans?

A: The Fuquay-Varina Town Commissioners adopted a five-year plan on June 1, 2020 that includes: 2020-21 clubhouse renovation, 2021-22 park master planning, 2022-23 construction of community center/senior wing, 2024-25 park construction (tentative).

Q: May we swim, fish, or boat in the ponds?

A: No swimming, fishing, or boating in the ponds.

Q: Can we set up folding chairs, a hammock, or put out a blanket for a picnic?

A: Yes, temporary items that will enhance a park visit may be used. We ask that visitors remove all items and dispose of trash properly.

Q: Are dogs allowed?

A: Yes, dogs are allowed, but must be leashed at all times.

Q: Will there be benches along the trail?

A: Yes, the planning for placement and installation is underway.

Q: Could I use my motorized scooter, onewheel, or dirt bike at the park?

A: Motorized vehicles or devices are not allowed on park property; the exception is motorized wheelchairs, which are allowed.

Q: Will there be playgrounds? disc golf? other amenities?

A: Future amenities will be determined during the master planning process, beginning in FY 2021.

Q: Does the public have access to the former clubhouse?

A: The building will remain closed until the future renovations have been completed.

Q: Are food trucks permitted to operate on park property?

A: No. Food vendors and seasonal merchants are not allowed on Town property except for Town-sponsored events.

A: No, unmanned aircrafts/drones are not allowed.
